CROSSROADS RANCH is a working horse ranch and farm providing a multi-subject educational and recreational experiences for youth in Sonoma County. We offer a variety of learning activities appropriate for kids from preschool (3 years) through high school (18 years).

Crossroads Ranch is a learning center, where activities focus around our horse and pony herd. We teach safe and sensitive handling, care, feeding, grooming, and riding of the horse. Along with our horse and pony herd, CROSSROADS RANCH is home for a variety of farm animals. Kids interact with sheep, goats, pigs, chickens, rabbits and of course, our barn cats and ranch dogs.

We support Home Schooling parents and Charter School teachers with their curriculum goals, providing opportunities that encompass P.E., Physical Science, Math, and Language Arts. Igniting natural curiosity and the excitement to learn, Home Schooled and Charter Schooled students alike are welcomed at CROSSROADS RANCH on Tuesdays from 10:00-1:00 in addition to our after-school daycare hours Mondays and Thursdays 3:00-5:00 and Wednesdays 2:00-5:00.
